




MOFCOM SCHOLARSHIP

To embrace a successful career and brighter future



1. WHAT IS MOFCOM SCHOLARSHIP?

Sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of the People's Republic of China for the purpose of educating high-end and inter-disciplinary talent;

Designed to foster high-end business officials and managerial personnel for developing countries, offering one-year and two-year master programs as well as three-year doctoral programs;

To build intellectual capacity and facilitate the economic and social development of the recipient countries;

To enhance bilateral relation between China and the recipient countries.

2. WHO CAN APPLY?

- -citizen of a developing country other than the People's Republic of China, and be healthy both physically and mentally; not over 45 years old (born after September 1, 1973)
- -applicants must have attained a Bachelor's degree or above, with threeyear or above working experience
- -priorities will be given to government officials at middle or senior level, or researchers or administrators of academic institutions at middle or senior level; and those intend to promote friendly exchanges and cooperation between China and recipient countries
- -English proficiency which meets the academic requirements of the program. English: IETS 6.0 or above; new TOEFL (score 80) or above.

2. WHO CAN APPLY? (continued)

-students learning in China or have been admitted in other Chinese scholarship programs are **NOT allowed** to apply in this program

-other requirements: see specific requirements listed in admission notice by related universities

3. PROGRAMS OFFERRED

Academic areas sponsored include but not limited to:

Public Policy, Public Administration, International Relation Study, Business Administration, Computer Engineering, etc.

4. WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THE SCHOLARSHIP?

- -tuition waiver;
- -teaching material fee waiver;
- -research and survey fee waiver;
- -dissertation guidance fee waiver;
- -one-off resettlement fee: 3000RMB
- -campus accommodation fee waiver;
- -stipend:
- 3000RMB per month per master student,
- 3500RMB per month per PhD student;
- -medical insurance
- -one-time round-trip international airfare for all the students (first time fly to China after enrollment and fly back to home country while graduation), and a maximum of "n-1" ("n" refers to the length of schooling year which is set while the student was enrolled by the program) round-trip international airfares for home visits (one time per year set at the end of an academic year).

6. HOW TO APPLY?

LINE 1: Academic application

See attached admission notice of universities

A typical application will include but not limited to:

- 1. Application form with a 2-inch photo and the applicant's signature.
- 2. Personal statement of research (A minimum of 500 words in English).
- 3. Copies of bachelor's degree certificate(s) and academic transcript(s).
- 4. Two recommendation letters from the applicant's employers and/or professors. Telephone numbers and email addresses of the referees must be included in the letters.
- 5. Employment verification.
- 6. English proficiency certificates.
- 7.Copy of the passport page of personal information (Ordinary Passport for Private Affairs only)



6. HOW TO APPLY? (continued)

LINE 2: Scholarship application

Please visit the online application system of Chinese Scholarship Council at http://laihua.csc.edu.cn, and register for an account. Select the program "Chinese Government Scholarship", fill in all the required information, and an application form will come into being

AFTER your academic and scholarship application, send a SCANNED copy of all your application documents to comercialchinacolombia@Hotmail.com, attention to Oficina Comercial, Subject: MOFCOM Scholarship application, asking for letter of recommendation. We will review your application and decide to issue the letter or not.

Please note that a letter of recommendation from my office, DOES NOT guarantee a successful application.



7. How will the application processed? (continued)

- 1. Application documents will be reviewed by Admission Committee, and prior enrollment will be given to outstanding applicants.
- 2. Each applicant will be supported by the scholarship for one program only.
- 3. The universities or the Chinese Embassy will send the Admission Letter and Visa Application Form for Study in China (JW201) to the scholarship winners around mid AUGUST.
